F&S – Field and Staff Detachment - The headquarters element consisting of the commanding officer and personnel, commissioned and enlisted, responsible for command and control of an organization, battalion and senior commands.

V. R. C. – Veteran Reserve Corps - The Veteran Reserve Corps (originally the Invalid Corps) was a military reserve organization created within the Union Army during the American Civil War to allow partially disabled or otherwise infirmed soldiers (or former soldiers) to perform light duty, freeing able-bodied soldiers to serve on the front lines. It existed from 1863 to 1869. (From Wikipedia, the free encyclopedia)
